

# Health Coverage for Licensed Family Home Providers *and* Employees of Washington State Licensed Child Care Facilities

Licensed Family Home providers have the option of choosing Health Care through the Child Care Health Benefits Program ([www.dcyf.wa.gov/services/ssps/childcarehealthbenefits](http://www.dcyf.wa.gov/services/ssps/childcarehealthbenefits)) administered by the Washington State Department of Children, Youth, and Families (DCYF). This opportunity is a result of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between Service Employees International Union (SEIU) Local 925 and the state of Washington.

Both Licensed Family Home providers and employees of any licensed child care facility in Washington State may be eligible for a \$0 premium, limited-time program that provides health insurance coverage through Washington Healthplanfinder ([www.wahealthplanfinder.org/us/en/health-coverage/who-can-sign-up/child-care-learn-more.html](http://www.wahealthplanfinder.org/us/en/health-coverage/who-can-sign-up/child-care-learn-more.html)), in partnership with Yakima Neighborhood Health Services. Providers may only be enrolled in one insurance coverage.
